



Course: OPITO Rigger Competence
(Stage 3 & 4)
Duration: 2 Days

Training

The aim & objectives of the OPITO Stage 3 competence assessment is to establish that the candidate has the required underpinning knowledge, understanding and practical skills to fulfil the role of Rigger safely and effectively.

The target group for Stage 4 are the personnel that wish to renew their OPITO Rigger Stage 3 or Stage 4 competent certificate

The Stage 3 & 4 Assessment is comprised of two parts, Knowledge & Practical Assessment, successful candidates that fully meet the knowledge and practical standard will then be deemed competent to undertake Rigger operations in the workplace.

Candidate pre-requisites

Candidate for Stage 3 assessment require;

(a) A Valid OPITO-approved Stage 1 Rigger Training Certificate

And

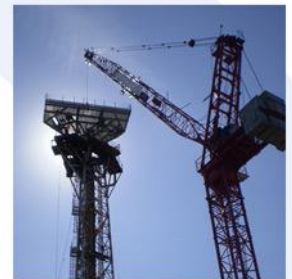
(b) A fully completed & valid logbook, based on the OPITO Stage 2 Rigger Standard workplace requirements.

Or

A formal letter from the candidate's employer or senior employer representative stating that the candidate has met the equivalent of the OPITO Stage 2 lifting experience logbook criteria.

The formal letter should include details of the employer/senior employer representative's position in the company, full contact details, and be signed and dated by the employer/senior employer representative.

Candidates for Stage 4 Reassessment require a valid OPITO-approved Stage 3 or 4 Rigger Certificate.

The knowledge assessment comprises a written test of which the pass mark is 80%.
